



## It's a good time to get on the electoral roll.

In April 2007 the process to redraw State electoral boundaries will begin. This follows changes to State electoral law reflecting 'one vote, one value' principles. As a first action, on 26 February 2007, a snapshot of the State electoral roll will be taken and the number of electors in the State calculated. Electoral boundaries will be redrawn using this calculation.

If you are an eligible Western Australian citizen, aged 18 or over, it is important that you are enrolled and your details are up-to-date.

Enrolment forms are easy to fill out and are available from any post office, Australian Electoral Commission divisional offices or from the Western Australian Electoral Commission office.
