Fact Sheet: Lodging an Objection

This document is designed to assist members of the public wishing to lodge an objection with the Western Australian Distribution Commission.

The Distribution process is scheduled to be completed before the end of 2019. The proposed boundaries were published on Friday 26 July 2019 on the Distribution website. Anyone wishing to lodge an objection must do so by 5.00pm on Monday 26 August 2019.

The Distribution Commissioners will review all objections received before deciding the final boundaries. There is no right of appeal against the final boundaries. These boundaries will be in place for the next State general election in March 2021, but any by-elections which may occur in the interim will be conducted in accordance with the current boundaries.

How to lodge an objection

Any person or organisation may lodge an objection.

Objections may cover a single or multiple districts and/or regions or the entire state and may relate to boundaries or names proposed for districts. There is no set format other than the requirement that objections be in writing.

Written objections should be addressed to the Executive Officer with a covering page as set out below. All objections will be published.
