Basically the Shire of Kulin agrees in principal with the submission prepared by the National Party WA. The proposals submitted by that party will see an electorate made up of predominately like communities and districts throughout the agricultural region. At present the Shire of Kulin is located in the far north west of the electoral district of Roe (along with the Shires of Kent and Lake Grace) with all three areas having little in common with the eastern area of Esperance.

The proposal for a "Central Lakes" region also has the following advantages:

- the town of Narrogin provides the majority of government services to our region and is centrally located. It makes sense to use the town of Narrogin as a central point in the electorate.
