Dear Commissioners

I write today in objection to the proposed new boundaries for Legislative Assembly Electorates in the South West.

My specific concern relates to the seat of Bunbury, as I believe following the local government boundary to define the seat of Bunbury does not reflect accurately on the city and surrounds in these times.

It is well known that Bunbury is now a growing satellite city with residential developments from Dalyellup in the south to Leschenault in the north. While these areas do exist outside the City of Bunbury, the reality is that Bunbury serves as a focal point to these residential areas, providing important services and such as medical services, these I believe are nearly always utilized by residents from Dalyellup and Leschenault. Bunbury's present doctor shortage is evidence of this.

I believe therefore that you as commissioners should look beyond the local government boundary when forming the new seat of Bunbury. The residents in the satellite residential areas around Bunbury would be better served by being included in the seat of Bunbury. Something that would better reflect the actual movements of residents and the demand that is placed on services in Bunbury.

I do hope you take my objections into consideration.
