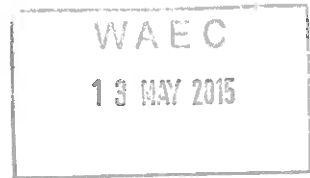

I write to voice my opposition and concern at the proposal for the suburbs of Golden Bay and Singleton to be moved to the South West Electoral Region.

Both suburbs fall within the City of Rockingham local government area and both are clearly metropolitan suburbs. They also have a strong community of interest with nearby Secret Harbour and other parts of the Warnbro electorate.

Apart from the obvious link to the metropolitan area, I am concerned that splitting the City of Rockingham between a metropolitan and regional electorate could create a number of problems for the residents and the local government authority itself.

The proposal appears to be short sighted and doesn't seem to take into account the growth in the Lakelands area within the City of Mandurah local government boundary and the South West Electoral Region.

I look forward to your further consideration of this matter.
