To: Redistribution Commissioners -

I object to electoral boundaries you have proposed for the Legislative Assembly.

This move serves to further diminish the influence of regional Australia, a voice already restrained by government policy and crucially needed as regional communities confront growing challenges.

These considerations necessitate a rethink of these boundary alterations – since the 1987 redistribution 12 lower house seats have been stripped from regional WA.

The proposed seat would span 1,000km from south to north and all but impossible for any local member to be held to account by their constituents.

I urge you to reevaluate your proposal, ensuring the preservation of the 16 regional seats.
