The impending removal of the seat of Moore and creation of a new city seat is grossly unfair to regional residents. The tyranny of distance is a significant factor in receiving proper representation for regional voters and residents. The influx of people to WA into Perth predominantly should see the creation of a new seat but not to the detriment of regional people. A simple formula of people to parliamentarian does not recognise the vastly different issues confronting regional people compared to their city counterparts.
