The plan to continue to reduce the regional centres capacity for representation in our government will continue the process of disenfranchising the people who look after our land and resources.

It is a process that has over the years has diminished the capacity of the rural areas to maintain the very important regional centres.

Population is not the only consideration in this process. It is logical to maintain the regional centres population through supporting the resources that fund these centres. In order to achieve this we need regional representation, issues of the rural towns cannot be fully appreciated by representatives that have not lived and worked in these towns.
