The Electoral Distribution Commissioners recently announced that the 2007 Electoral Distribution was to commence on Wednesday 4 April 2007. This started a seven-month process to determine the placement of new electoral boundaries, which will take effect from the next State general election, due in 2009.

The closing date for the lodgement of written suggestions is **5.00 pm, Friday 4 May 2007**. Copies of the written suggestions will be available on the web site after this date.
