

2015 ELECTORAL BOUNDARIES REVIEW – OBJECTION TO PROPOSED NAMING OF "MOLLOY"

I refer to the above Review undertaken by the Electoral Distribution Commissioners and wish to submit an objection to the proposed re-naming of the current Warren-Blackwood Electorate to "Molloy".

Council would prefer the Warren-Blackwood district name to be retained but in light of the proposed boundary including the Stirling Range National Park area, Council would have no objections to the former name of Blackwood-Stirling being applied as the new Electoral district.

Whilst Council acknowledges the comments of the Commissioners in respect to the contributions of Georgiana Molloy, who lived in the Augusta area in the mid-1800's, Council is of the opinion that electors in the electorate would distinguish the name of Blackwood-Stirling more readily than "Molloy".

I trust that the Commissioners will give due consideration to the above submission.
