OBJECTION TO THE REMOVAL AND REDISTRIBUTION OF THE ELECTORATE OF EYRE.

We electors of the electorate of Eyre, W. A., respectfully commit this objection to the removal and redistribution of the electorate of Eyre.

Our initial objection is that, the country especially in the locality of Esperance will lose its voice in parliament and therefore its champion and consideration of local matters in the government of Western Australia.

Secondly dividing the electorate, half to Wagin and half to Kalgoorlie splits and divides the community of Esperance.

Aligning with Kalgoorlie is acceptable, as a tremendous amount of work has already been done unite the two communities, although that will make the Kalgoorlie electorate gigantic, unwieldy and extremely difficult for one man or woman to efficiently represent.

Aligning with Wagin, is ridiculous as both regions are separate and completely different, where I believe Wagin is an inland area and to my understanding mainly a wheat and sheep, agricultural area, Esperance is an area of great diversity, with an enlarging Port catering to both export and import of a great variety of products.

Esperance is also a thriving centre of tourism, a centre of commerce for the region and a focal point of supply and export for agriculture, mining and engineering.

Also there is such a great distance between the centres of Wagin and Esperance, that the logistics of handling such an electorate would be impractical, beyond reason and extremely exhausting.

This is our belief, our comment and our reasoning behind our objection.
