

SUGGESTION REGARDING THE NAME OF THE PROPOSED BLACKWOOD-STIRLING DISTRICT

The Liberal Party would like to make a final suggestion in regard to the name of a proposed district.

We would request that in finalising the Redistribution, consideration be given to naming the Blackwood-Stirling district as Warren-Stirling, or any name that included "Warren" in its title.

Whereas the name "Blackwood" disappeared for a generation between 1974 and 1996, the name "Warren" has continually been used for a Manjimup-based district since 1950. As such it has greater resonance with a larger number of electors than does "Blackwood". The Shires of Manjimup, Nannup, Bridgetown-Greenbushes and Boyup Brook all have an historic association with Warren.

We consider that the retention of the "Warren" name would be widely supported by electors.
