RE: Objection to boundary between districts of Jandakot and Cockburn

Dear Sirs,

Thank you for this opportunity to comment on the boundaries proposed in the recent publication of "Western Australia's Proposed Electoral Boundaries June 2007".

I wish to object to the boundary proposed between Jandakot and Cockburn in the South Metropolitan Region. The proposed boundary runs from Kwinana Freeway, along Berrigan Drive to North Lake Road. My objection is that this boundary splits the suburb of South Lake in two – with some residents falling into Cockburn and some into Jandakot. I believe this is confusing and it would be simpler if the entirety of South Lake was captured in one district.

I suggest either of the following boundaries be adopted instead:

Suggestion One

From Kwinana Freeway, down Berrigan Drive then left along Semple Court to North Lake Road.

This would capture the full suburb of South Lake within the district of Jandakot.

Suggestion Two

From Kwinana Freeway, down Beeliar Drive to North Lake Road.

This would capture the full suburb of South Lake as well as the new suburb of Cockburn Central within the district of Jandakot.

Either of these suggestions will not change the numbers of enrolled electors by too much. It would make identification of the district of the elector a lot easier, as well as only having one Member of Parliament representing the suburb of South Lake.

Thank you once again for the opportunity to object and I hope for this slight change to be taken up.
