Subject: Objection to proposed electoral boundaries

Hi,

I wish to lodge an objection to the proposed electoral boundaries, with respect to the Gosnells Town Centre and Port Coogee.

Gosnells Town Centre

- Gosnells and Kalamunda Electorates

The Gosnells Town Centre - located between the railway and Canning River on Albany Highway in Gosnells, services the residential area in the Gosnells electorate - yet the Town Centre is located in the Kalamunda electorate. I suggest the electorate boundary follow the Canning River, so that the Gosnells and its Town Centre are kept in the one electorate.

Port Coogee

- Fremantle and Cockburn electorates.

The proposed electorate boundary runs along Ocean Road - right through the middle of the Port Coogee development (currently under construction) - Ocean Road is to be closed and the land incorporated in the development. A better solution would be for the electorate boundary to run along the Cockburn Road deviation (Fremantle-Rockingham Highway Reserve) and Powell Road.
