Submission on Review to Proposed Changes for Mid-West Boundaries

I oppose the changes on the following grounds:

1. There is no common Community of Interest that is particularly important for Legislative Assembly members where local knowledge of local issues are essential.
2. Equality of representation, where electorates have similar numbers of voting electors, must not be elevated above the quality of representation.
3. The proposed boundary changes include 24 Local Government Authorities, who each have their own community of interest but are mostly dissimilar to adjoining LGA's.
4. These community of interest include Indigenous Affairs, fishing, agriculture, manufacturing, road infrastructure, and health including the chronic shortage of General Practitioners.
