I write to express my extreme disappointment in the decision to combine the regional electorates of North West Central and the Moore Electorate. These areas could not be more diverse in their production, lifestyle and demographic. The need for representation in Parliament is more important than those who live closer to the metropolitan area because the tyranny of distance is against them.

Why do you not consider distance in your analysis?
