Looking through the changes made to the electoral boundaries of Geraldton, I have noticed a 474% increase in size of the area, in spite of the current boundaries that were present last election still meeting the target population, and the extra boundary increase not significantly improving that target in any meaningful way.

This seems somewhat absurd for a non-LGA area like Geraldton to be given an LGA-like area increase when it is not necessary to fulfil the requirements of being an electorate.

This submission is an objection to the proposed boundaries for Geraldton. Regional Centres should not be considered the same as rural and remote towns.
