### A response to my own submission

I have just spotted additional errors in my submission in relation to numbers provided and map errors.

- 1. I proposed transferring 1729 electors from the suburb of Gelorup to Warren-Blackwood and didn't realize that some of these (675) were in the Bunbury district instead of Collie-Preston.
- 2. The northern border for what I have designated "Leschenault" should end at the suburb of Leschenault and not include Parkfield. This is only a minor boundary change.
- I proposed transferring 2560 electors from the Shire of Augusta-Margaret River when this number included electors from Coweramup(1769) and Gracetown(170) and didn't adjust this number when removing them but did not include them in the total.
- 4. I missed some electors in Vasse that were to be transferred to Warren-Blackwood but were counted. Including 1 elector from Nillup.
- I made boundary errors on several maps as well as incorrectly colour coding areas that were not supposed to be incorporated and have resubmitted updated maps to fix these errors.
  - 6. Albany taking in Hay reduces Roe by a further 133sqkm and 2 electors on its LDA but given it loses the LDA after redistribution into Central Wheatbelt this doesn't effect its overall numbers.
- 7. Kimberley doesn't take in the Shire of Wiluna as stated this was from an earlier draft that wasn't corrected and later went to Moore.
  - 8. The 1,167 electors that come from Bicton to Fremantle are from the suburb of Fremantle.
- Forgot to deduct the 402 electors from the 2880 transferred from Shire of Denmark to Roe but the amount stated was correct. Accidently deducted Roes LDA from the base amount instead of the base + LDA.
- 10. The number of electors of Perth after taking in suburbs should have read 57,666 this doesn't affect its division as that number was used when splitting the districts.
- 11. Baldavis should also include the currently unpopulated suburb of Keralup from Darling Range and Warnbro thus reducing Warnbro to the coastal strip.
- 12. The 78 electors from the suburb of Maddington and the 326 from the suburb of Orange Grove gained by Thornlie come from Forrestfield not from Cannington as stated.

The solutions and new district enrollments are as follows:

Transfer the remaining 1,054 electors from the suburb of Gelorup from what I have designated Preston-Warren to Bunbury. This increases Bunbury to 32,314 electors and decreases Preston-Warren to 30,981 electors. This would also increase what I have designated Leschenault by an additional 675 electors to 30,624 electors.

Transfer the 1769 electors from the suburb of Coweramup and 170 electors from the suburb of Gracetown from what I have designated Bussellton to what I have designated Preston-Warren. This increases Preston-Warren to 32,920 electors and decreases Busselton to 30,640 electors.

Neither the 531 electors from Wiluna or the 2,732 electors from the LDA associated with that territory were counted towards Kimberleys enrollment so it doesn't affect the overall number. However the 182,156sqkm that covers that shire was and needs to removed and Kimberley should read 792,991sqkm.
