RE: Comment on WA Liberal Party's Submission on Cockburn Electorate

The Yangebup Progress Association Inc (YPA) is the official residents' association (recognised by the City of Cockburn) that advocates for the interests of Yangebup and its residents.

The YPA has been made aware that the WA Liberal Party has suggested that Yangebup be shifted from the electorate of Cockburn to the electorate of Willagee in the upcoming redistribution of state electorates. The YPA strongly opposes that suggestion.

Yangebup has been in the electorate of Cockburn for most of the period since the creation of the electorate in 1962. Yangebup is in the heart of the City of Cockburn and has significant community of interest with neighbouring suburbs in the electorate of Cockburn.

These include:

- The Yangebup Family Centre – this is used extensively by families in Yangebup, Beeliar, Lake Coogee, and South Lake. It is a common meeting place for residents of these suburbs, such as at the monthly Community Eats event as well adults' classes, day car and pre-kindy.
- The eastern portion of Yangebup falls in the local intake area for Lakeland Senior High School, together with the eastern portion of Beeliar, most of Cockburn Central, and South Lake.
- The western portion of Yangebup falls in the local intake area for Fremantle College, together with the western portion of Beeliar, Coogee, Lake Coogee, and Munster.

- Yangebup and Beeliar, together with Cockburn Central and Success further to the east, are located either side of Beeliar Drive, which is the main arterial road used by residents. These suburbs all have a shared interest in the upkeep and improvement of Beeliar Drive, as well as the bus routes that run along it (eg. 530, 531).
- The nearest major shopping centres used by Yangebup residents are Beeliar Village (located in Beeliar) and Beeliar Hive (located in Yangebup), which together form a broader shopping precinct bisected by Beeliar Drive.

It would not be sensible to separate Yangebup from the surrounding suburbs of Beeliar, Cockburn Central, Coogee, Lake Coogee, Munster, South Lake, and Success. The YPA therefore strongly recommends that Yangebup remain in the electorate of Cockburn.
